Learning Intention

We are learning to write three letter words by exploring different materials for writing.

Success Criteria

I can use the letters learnt so far in three letter words.
I can explore different materials for forming three letter words.

Resources

Sticks that can be collected by children or these can be provided. Our learning outdoor was during a fantastic winter day when we were extremely lucky to have snow.

We can also use sand or soil during time when snow is not available.

Activity

1. Children to be splitted in groups.
2. Each group to choose a leader for their group.
3. Teacher to say a letter and each leader needs to find a three-letter word that begins with that letter.
4. Children work together to write the word in the snow using the stick provided. Children may come with more than one example. They can write as many words as they find. This is an opportunity for some children that find writing difficult to get engaged in the group and to gain confidence in writing.
5. Change the leader and play again.
6. Each child will have the chance to be the leader.

Teacher observation and recording by using an iPad.
